### Energizing Innovative Lessons

**Purpose:** Many teachers develop innovative classroom projects, but lack the funds to implement the projects. Bright Ideas funds them.

#### **Eligibility:**

- ❖ Teachers in grades K-12 in the LCEC service area.
- ❖ Projects must benefit students in grades K-12.
- ❖ Teachers may only be an applicant of one project per school year.

**Subjects:** Grants are open to all subjects.

**Grant limit:** Projects can be funded up to \$2,000 or they may be partially funded. The maximum grant amount is \$2,000.

**Deadline:** All applications must be **typed** and received at one of Lea County Electric Cooperative's three offices by last Friday in August. You can email your applications to <a href="mailto:memberservices@lcecnet.com">memberservices@lcecnet.com</a> or mail to P.O. Drawer 1447, Lovington, NM 88260. Applications received after deadline will not be considered.

#### **Selection Criteria:**

- Uses innovative, creative learning experiences for students (30 percent)
- Provides instructional experiences otherwise unavailable (20 percent)
- Involves teamwork (15 percent)
- Directly involve students (10 percent)
- Clearly defined goals and learning objectives (10 percent)
- Provides ongoing benefits to students (10 percent)
- Provides an adequate budget summary (5 percent)

#### If grant is awarded:

- Grant must be used within 18 months.
- ❖ Applicant will submit a report about the outcome of the grant.
- Applicant grants sponsors the right to use their name, photo and information about grant in publicity.

- Teachers may only be an applicant of one project per school year.
- Application <u>must</u> adhere to word limits.
- Applicants agree that their name, photo and project may be used in print, broadcast and other forms of media and publications promoting LCEC.
- Bright Idea Grants awarded the previous year cannot be resubmitted.
- All applications must be received at LCEC by the last Friday in August.
